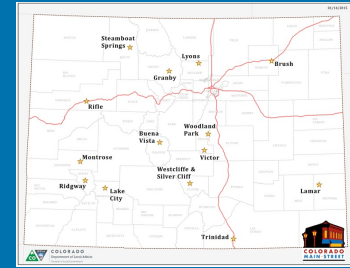

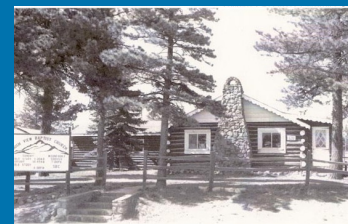

Williams's log cabin was built around 1890 as a side gabled log cabin, a typical style for the era. Not much is known about this private residence until it was bought by the Williams family in 1981 and turned into "William's Mountain Home Furniture Store". It continues to offer beautiful affordable log furniture and is a land mark in Woodland Park with it's giant log chair out front on Midland Avenue.

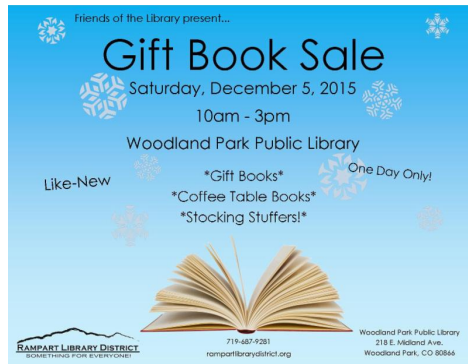
